

Points to Note

- PLEASE BE EARLY. Doors are open from 2pm.
 There will be an expected huge turnout of 50,000 people and there will be security checks. Everyone must be seated by 3.30pm. Your seat may be released if you are not seated by 3.30pm or if the stadium is full, whichever is earlier.
- DO BRING YOUR TICKET. Tickets are required for entry including for all children. You can only enter at the Designated Gate marked out on your ticket.
- The event will be conducted in English.
- SECURITY CONTROLS. There are restrictions on items that can be brought into
 the National Stadium, such as no selfie-sticks, no drones and no bottled water,
 camera with zoom lens, big bags and baby pram... Check out their website

 information. Water and a goodie bag will be provided. There are also water coolers
 in the vicinity.
