Whole Life Inventory

Whole Life is a life-span approach to Christian discipleship. There are five key pillars that are important to discipleship for churches and families - Faith, Identity, Relationships, Sexuality, and Values.

From **15 October to 5 November**, St Hilda's Church will run a church-wide survey called *Whole Life Inventory* in partnership with Focus on the Family Singapore. This is a survey for churches to find out how individuals, couples, and families are faring in St Hilda's Church.

We believe that the Inventory will enable us to better understand the needs of our church and see how we can further effectively disciple our people.

As long as you are 13 years old (including Secondary 1 students) and above, and attends church services regularly at St Hilda's Church, you can participate in the *Whole Life Inventory*. It will take about 15 minutes to complete.

The *Whole Life Inventory* is anonymous and confidential. No personal names are required for your responses.

It is important that we participate in the Inventory in order for the leadership to have an accurate picture of the health of St Hilda's Church as a church family.

We will provide more details on how to take the Inventory later.
