ASH WEDNESDAY

Ash Wednesday derives its name from the practice of placing ashes on the foreheads as a sign of penitence, with the words "You are dust and to dust you shall return" (Gen 3:19). This reminder of our sinful nature helps us to stay in touch with the real human condition that we all share and to recognise our need for God's saving grace in Jesus.

LENT

Lent begins on Ash Wednesday and is a 40-day period of preparation before Easter (without counting the Sundays in between). This Scripturally-inspired 40-day season is modelled after the time when our Lord Jesus fasted and prayed and overcame temptation while in the wilderness. Lent is therefore a time of soul-searching as we prepare ourselves for Good Friday, Jesus' death on the cross that purchased our salvation, and for Easter, His resurrection which brought us eternal life. Christians throughout the centuries have used Lent for prayers, devotion, repentance and fasting (e.g. from food or other things that have become too important in our life) in order to refocus our life on Jesus. As disciples of Jesus, we are called to do all of this throughout the year but the season of Lent is a timely reminder for us to be more intentional in the practice of these disciplines.

All throughout Lent, as we draw near to God with a contrite heart, we are assured of God's faithfulness that he demonstrated supremely in Jesus. This year's devotional booklet from the Bible Society guides us under this theme of "His Undying Faithfulness". We pray that it will be a great help for you!
