A Spiritual Retreat for Lay Leaders

A spiritual retreat is an opportunity to break away from our usual routine in order to dedicate time and space to deepen our communion with God. As spiritual theologian Gordon Smith suggest, a spiritual retreat especially “enables us to make spiritual and emotional space for an intentional encounter with Christ, through which we awaken the presence of the Spirit in our lives” (Smith 2003, 5). It is to be a spacious place where we once again hear God affirming us as his beloved children. God’s restorative affirmation frees us to be ourselves and so helps us to do the deep soul soundings necessary to be in touch with the deep desires of God and our life in God. A spiritual retreat can usher us into deeper communion with our Triune God to enable us to live from that sacred communion – with God and for the world.
