We are into the 2nd cycle of our prayer journey:

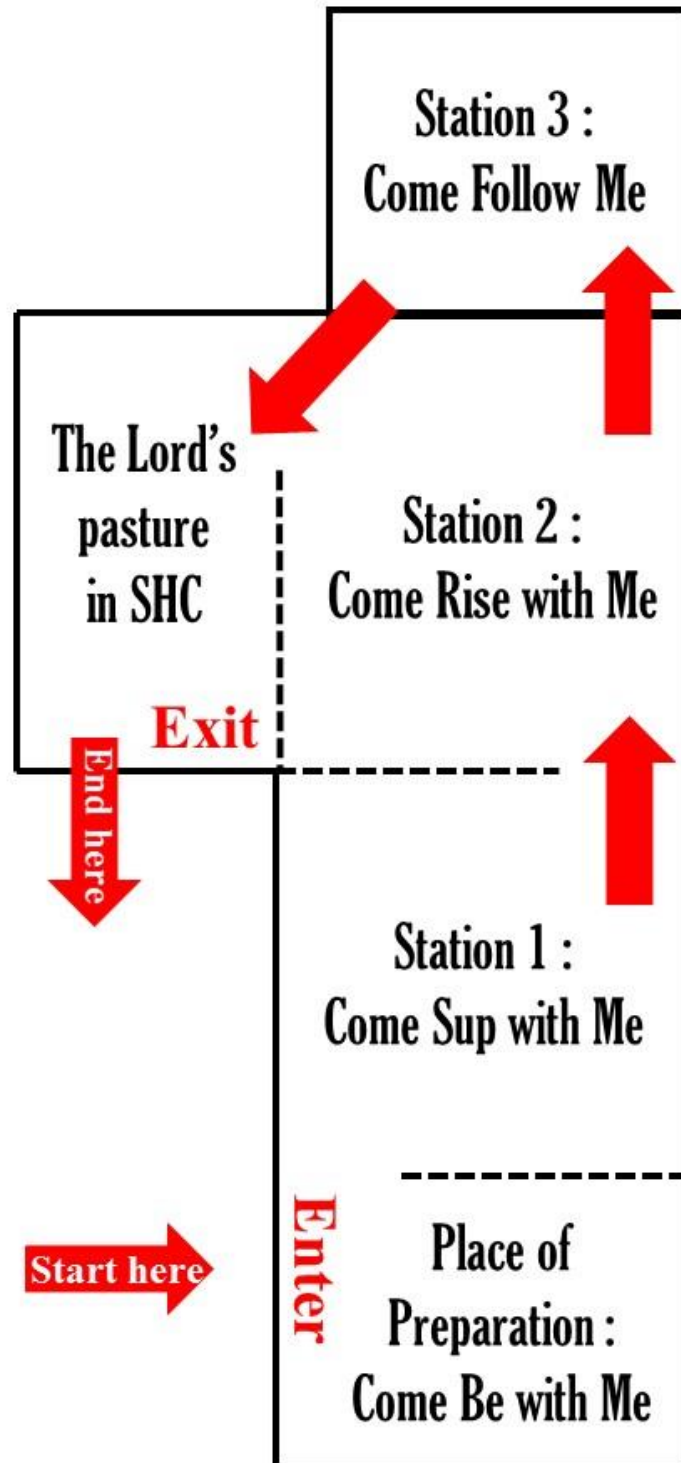
EMPOWERING BY THE HOLY SPIRIT (6— 27 Mar)

- Place of Preparation: Come Be with Me (2 Cor 4:6-18)
- Station 1: Come Sup with Me (Luke 22:14-20 and John 17:20-23)
- Station 2: Come Rise with Me (John 20:1-16)
- Station 3: Come Follow Me (John 21:15-17)
- The Lord's Pasture in SHC

Before you start on the prayer journey, spend some time in the **PLACE OF PREPARATION** to slow down; stop and be still before you embark on this journey. Take note of what is around you. In all of this, God is present. Right here, right now. God's presence fills this ordinary place.

Set aside sufficient time to complete the prayer journey so that you can spend unhurried time in reflection and contemplation. We recommend at least 1.5 hours. If this is not possible, you can also complete it in a few visits. For a full experience, you are encouraged to follow the sequence of the stations.

In your prayer time, the Lord will speak to you. We encourage you to journal these impressions at the end of the prayer time.

**Vicar's sermon on 14 Feb 2016: God's All Sufficient and Surpassing Grace*

STATION 1: COME SUP WITH ME

*There was an air of festivities. It was the Passover.
A day of joyful remembrance. Victory! Freedom!
Jesus told Peter and John to go and make preparations.*

Read: **Luke 22:14-20**

Luke recorded Jesus' words:

"This is my body given for you. . . . This cup is the new covenant in my blood, which is poured out for you."



What is your experience during Holy Communion every Sunday?

How do you remember Christ during Holy Communion?

What do you do "in remembrance of me."?

Meditate: **John 17:20-23**

Look at the broken loaf and the cup.

Now look at the chairs around the table.

Holy Communion includes our communion with the Body of Christ.

What is your experience of unity and love in SHC?

How can God use you to demonstrate unity and love to the body of Christ?

What grace can you to extend to each other?

Is there someone in particular that you need to extend grace to?

STATION 2: COME RISE WITH ME

*It was supposed to be a Passover meal with their Beloved Lord.
Never would they expect to see Him suffered a brutal death. He was
supposed to be their leader. He was supposed to take care of them.*

*He was to establish His kingdom.
Now he is dead in a borrowed tomb.*

Read: John 20:1-16



It was a beautiful garden but Mary was downcast and broken hearted. She was shocked and felt loss from the dramatic acts of the past few days. But she would discover that her confusion was only just beginning. In the midst of death she would find

Look at the empty shroud. Mary was looking for Jesus.

Life can be puzzling with its “empty tombs” and “missing bodies”. Like Mary, do you have questions that needed answer? Bring them before the Lord.

Where is He?

Where is He when you needed Him most?

Jesus is asking you today: Who are you looking for?

Jesus said to her, “Mary”

Look at the empty cross.



There you encountered the Risen Christ.

Do you hear the voice of Jesus?

Open your heart and allow the Resurrected Christ to enter in your circumstances.

John 20:18 ... I have seen the Lord! ...

STATION 3: COME FOLLOW ME

Watch the video clip.

It was not too long ago when Peter denied the Lord at a fireplace.

How can you identify with Peter?

How have you let the Lord down?

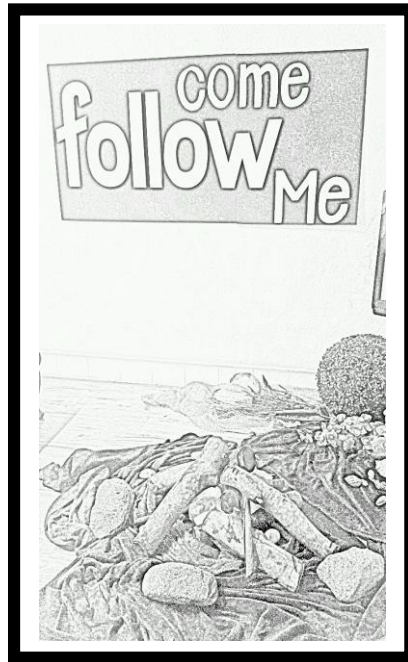
Read **John 21:9-17** a few times.
