POKÉMON GO

The game Pokémon Go was launched in Singapore on 6 August 2016. It is played on a smartphone while walking around exploring real world locations.

While Pokémon Go has been hugely popular worldwide, serious concerns have also been raised about players trespassing on private properties, disturbing at places of worship, putting themselves in danger from traffic and even robbers.

I would like to assure St Hilda's Church worshipers that we take the sanctity of our premises seriously, as a private property and a consecrated place of worship set apart for the Almighty God. We need to look out for the safety of pedestrians on our narrow streets and in our crowded car parks. Our Kindergarten and our Friends Centres at Jalan Batu are safe places where little children and seniors respectively are educated and served without worrying about strangers poking around with smartphones.

For all these reasons, we are writing to Pokémon's publishers, Niantic, Inc., to exclude the use of all our premises from all aspects of gameplay through the feedback channels provided. We will monitor the situation and make more robust representations as necessary.

We graciously seek the kind cooperation of everyone not to play Pokémon at all times in any St Hilda's property, in order to uphold the sanctity, safety and security of our premises for the glory of God.
