**St Hilda's Church**  
**Nomination Process**  
**for the next Bishop of Singapore**

### Extraordinary Synod

The Right Rev Rennis Ponniah has served as our Diocesan Bishop since 2012. His term will end upon his retirement on 16 Sep 2020.

The Diocesan Chancellor Richard Magnus, has informed the Synod that an **Extraordinary Meeting of Synod** will be held on 8 and 9 November 2019 at St Andrew's Cathedral to nominate candidates for the next Diocesan Bishop. The Most Rev Datuk Ng Moon Hing, the Archbishop of the Province of South East Asia, will be the Speaker at the Extraordinary Meeting of Synod.

The Synod will spend time in prayer, fasting, worship and listening to the Lord. It will receive guidance from Archbishop Ng and Bishop Rennis, and discuss the needs of the Diocese in the coming years, as well as the qualities and qualifications of the incoming Bishop.

Each member of the House of Clergy and the House of Laity will proceed, in respective houses, to nominate by secret ballot up to 2 candidates for consideration.

After the Extraordinary Synod, the **Archbishop's Advisory Board** will be convened by the Chancellor. Only the Chancellor and Registrar will view the results of the nomination and present the top 3 candidates in a report to the Provincial House of Bishops (consisting of the four Diocesan Bishops in our Province) by end January 2020.

The Provincial House of Bishops will interview candidates, prayerfully deliberate and make the final decision. The announcement of Bishop-elect will be made to the Diocese by March 2020, giving five to six months for the handover process with Bishop Rennis.

### Pastoral Guidance

Chancellor urged the Diocese that the process be prayerful and in "hol[iness] as befit[ting] the House of God" (Ps 93:5) and that our incoming Bishop be sovereignly (Ps 97:1) chosen and appointed.

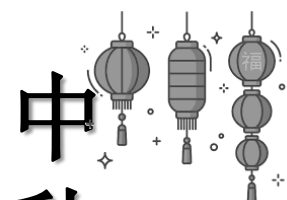
The Archdeacon of Singapore, Bishop Low Jee King, has also written to all Clergy, Deaconesses and Synod Representatives on 4 July 2019 to offer his Pastoral Guidance for the Nomination Process. Bishop Low encouraged all involved to:

1. Pray earnestly to God for suitable candidates.
2. Fast and pray on Friday 8 Nov before the Extraordinary Synod.
3. Refrain from persuading, promoting or lobbying for any candidate.
4. Nominate the candidates with reverence and fear of God.
5. Praise God for the final result and continue to serve in the capacity in which God has called each of us.

**May I urge all of us in St Hilda's Church to observe the pastoral guidance given, and especially to fast, pray and seek God's sovereign will and purpose for the future leadership of the Diocese.**
