## **Hello, Constance, How Are You?**

Many of us praying for Constance, often inquire. The short answer is: alive, kicking and full of the joy, zest and Spirit of the Lord. Yes, she has been living in Svay Prahoot (SP) for almost 6 months now as full time missionary Principal for our CCOR Language Centre (CLC). Three weeks ago, Vicar and three SHC members visited her. She may be a couple of pounds lighter; we didn't weigh her, but she is definitely coping well.

Workwise, for sure, she was thrown into the deep end. Living a radically changed lifestyle in the village environment and starting a school to provide English tuition to school children from the 4 public schools in the commune, you can imagine she faced all kinds of starting-up issues and problems. But she transcended them all in the power of the Spirit.

Thanks to a small band of former teachers in SHC who supported her to plan lessons and provide counsel on school management. They also prayed with her and even accompanied and worked with her in SP, one of whom lived there for two whole months.

In our recent visit, we prayed with Constance and Vicar ministered to her. Taking Vicar's advice, Constance now goes fortnightly to our CCOP church in Phnom Penh, where she mixes with other missionaries and is ministered to by our CCOP pastors and their wives. This is necessary for her long-term emotional and spiritual health, not just living for work but also living in the wider missionary and Christian community.

At present, CLC runs 10 tuition classes every working day for 130 students. Their age ranges from 6 to 16. If we had allowed, more students would have been enrolled. Some mothers cried when their children were not enrolled, such is the value that parents place on English language learning.

When we arrived at our CLC, we heard the children singing "Jesus loves me, this I know" in their 3<sup>rd</sup> floor classrooms from downstairs. What a joy for us! And the children are so well-behaved in class, contrary to our imagined misgivings when we started. Look at their happy faces over leaf.

The Principal of the leading school in the commune said to us: Thank you so much for your English tuition classes. Normally, the children do not have a chance to learn English until Primary 4 or only at secondary level in some schools. Now, thanks to you, they can speak some English words and sing English songs. What an encouragement! Praise the Lord!

The three young graduate Cambodian teachers in CLC are doing well too. But a vacancy for the 4<sup>th</sup> teacher was not filled for nearly 3 months. Constance was very short-handed. It's not easy to find suitable teachers to work in the village. Thank God, on our recent visit, we interviewed a good candidate. He is a graduate of Svay Rieng University, worked three years in micro finance, speaks good English and has a heart for Christian ministry and evangelism. He is the son of a pastor. Three months short-handed seemed a pretty long time. But God said, wait, for He is never too early or late. We learnt a lesson.

The new building, Hope Anglican Centre (HAC), is functioning well. There are some teething maintenance problems which we are tackling. We are also making some improvements to the ground in our compound with stone pavement and landscaping. HAC will be dedicated by Bishop Rennis on 26<sup>th</sup> October 2018.

Thank you, dear brothers and sisters for all your prayers and financial gifts. May the Lord bless you richly. Hope some of you can also go to teach in CLC for a month or more. All glory to God.
