3. ARTWORKS IN MANNA HOUSE

This morning, you will see three vibrant and beautiful paintings on the wall of Manna House as you queue for your after-service morning or afternoon snack and beverage. They are all painted and donated to the church by third-generation church members Kyle (16 years) and Isabel Koh (15 years), children of Serena and Danny Koh.

At one end of Manna House's wall is a painting by Isabel. It is dominated by a large fish.

"The artwork that I did was in memory of my late grandpa. He and grandma always cooked for us every Sunday. His food is the thing I will always remember him by, as he was not very outspoken and usually showed my family love by cooking for us. The painting shows a few of the different types of dishes he would cook, with my favourite fishballs at the corner."

At the other end of the wall are two smaller early still-life paintings by Kyle, Bel's older brother.

"The artworks here are still life paintings using acrylic paint on canvas. I was inspired to do this through my love for exploring new techniques for art and the raw finish of acrylic paintings. These were two of my very first paintings, each taking slightly under two hours to finish. It was an enjoyable medium as it was one that didn't require you to be too careful but actually required a great deal of boldness to be done."
