An Update on Svay Rieng Education Centre and Multi-Purpose Building

- 1) After the rainy season in November and December, when construction work practically halted, the <u>building is making good progress</u>. It is currently at the stage of pouring concrete for the 3rd floor.
- 2) In parallel, we are planning the <u>outfitting for the interior</u> of the building comprising the worship and multi-purpose hall and a large meeting & classroom on the ground floor, 8 small apartments on the 2nd floor, and 7 classrooms on the 3rd floor. Each floor will have its own bath and toilet facilities. Richard Wee, our church member, a professional Interior Designer, is leading the interior design and outfitting working with local carpenter / furniture contractors.
- 3) We have been talking with the schools in 2 communes, Commune Koek Pring (where Svay Prahoot Village is located) and Commune Chheu Teal which are desirous of our help to provide students and teachers with English tuition, & other subjects (for students), and generally ways of helping to improve their teaching or school standards. Education could include life skills training.



- 4) As a wider part of our community work, when the building is completed, we are also considering planning <u>a 4-day on-site clinic</u> in our new building once every month for dental and general health care for residents. This clinic will be staffed by nurse practitioners (not doctors) who can give primary care, a practice commonly in developing countries. These nurse practitioners will be provided by our medical NGO partner, One2One, on a heavily subsidised basis for us.
- 5) All the ministries above will be supported by <u>evangelistic programs and activities</u>, and <u>pastoral and prayer ministries</u> such as our missions, youth bible camps and children's ministry from SHC.
- 6) The target Building Fund is \$\$300,000. So far, we have received about \$\$200,000 from your generous giving, but is <u>still short of another \$\$100,000</u>. We appeal to our congregation members in SHC to help complete the giving to the target amount.
- 7) We are confident God's grace will enable us to meet this need with His abundance. Thank you and God bless your giving.
