# Sanctuary Update from the Building Committee 29<sup>th</sup> Nov 2018

When the current work on the sanctuary was almost completed, a termite infestation in the roof area was detected. The wooden ceiling planks had 48 planks badly damaged and the ceiling was taken down. There were 10 wooden members of the roof structure that were hidden by the ceiling that were also damaged. Specialist contractors established that the main roof structure is still intact but would only last for another 10-15 years.

Two options were tabled to PCC for restoration of sanctuary.

- Repair of damaged wooden roof structure with one to one replacement without touching the current roof tile and battens. Cost estimate \$ 295,000. Estimated completion in March 2019.
- 2. A full replacement of the sanctuary's roof with new roof structures and roof tiles. Cost estimate \$ 560,000. Estimated completion in June 2019.

PCC unanimously decided for option 2.

The following reasons guided the decision:

- Longevity of the solution. Option 1 would confront the next generation of church members with the roof replacement.
- We only have a small number of spare tiles left. Once they are used up, the whole roof would need to be re-tiled because the current tiles are no longer available. Option 1 carries risk of unforeseen accidents with damages to existing roof tiles beyond the spare numbers we have.
- The sanctuary is not yet a preserved building which simplifies projects like this. Once it will be preserved, a roof replacement would likely be more complicated and more expensive.

Visible work on the roof will only commence in February after obtaining the necessary permits.

Please continue to pray for our sanctuary project, especially for the safety of the workers.
