

1942-1945, COTE rented an Attap shed at Lorong Thangam for worship service 1945-1946 COTE congregation gathered at Seletar hanger. 1947-1962 the congregation met in the St. Mary's Church at R.A.F Seletar. In 1962, Captain RWG Freer of R.A.F.got permission for this land to build a Church.
