## **WHITSUNDAY – 4 JUNE 2017**

Whitsunday, the 'festival of Pentecost' is upon us. It wonderfully commemorates the descent of the Holy Spirit upon Christ's disciples. ### **Jurong Anglican Church Plant**

This new Jurong Church will be a house of prayer and a beacon for the gospel and salvation to the community, where God's name will be glorified.

### **Church of the Epiphany (COTE) Redevelopment Project**

1942-1945, COTE rented an Attap shed at Lorong Thangam for worship service 1945-1946 COTE congregation gathered at Seletar hanger.

1947-1962 the congregation met in the St. Mary's Church at R.A.F Seletar. In 1962, Captain RWG Freer of R.A.F. got permission for this land to build a Church.

On 1<sup>st</sup> January 1966, the foundation stone of COTE was laid.

The Church has been here for about 51 years. The surrounding areas have been developed. And we have neighbourhoods like Sengkang, Hougang, Ang Mo Kio, Punggol, Fernvale etc. We are situated at the North- East of Singapore where there is no other Anglican Church.

We have to bring the Gospel of Jesus Christ to our neighbourhood and around. We are looking forward for growth and also to have multi – language services. At present the space is limited, we have to build a new church building. We alone cannot build the Church, therefore we are appealing to all for a generous giving on this Whitsunday.
