Dear Friends,

We are into the 3<sup>rd</sup> week of a sermon series on 'Giving and Worship'.

The series aims to strengthen our understanding of the biblical concept of giving as part of our worship and to address various practical aspects giving. We are offering this teaching at a time where our church finances are healthy. We pray that this sermon will be particularly helpful for those of us who want to grow in the spiritual discipline of giving.

We started by looking at God as the one who gives *generously* and *sacrificially*. Genesis 1+2 testify of God's generosity in creation. In Jesus, he generously and graciously offers forgiveness. He shows Abraham in Genesis 22 that he will always provide, even to the extent of sacrificing His own Son Jesus for the sins of humankind. This challenges us to give generously and sacrificially like the two women in the gospel, Luke 7:36ff and Luke 21.

Today, we will receive encouragement from the *joyful* giving of Israel in the desert, building the tabernacle as God's dwelling place and the centre of worship in Exodus 25+35. On October 6, we will look at giving according to the OT law, *tithe and offering*, through Malachi 3, and understand how these terms apply to us today.

The remaining two sermons will focus at the *New Testament teaching* on giving, e.g. 2 Corinthians 8+9. We will also learn what we can (and can't) expect from God if we give faithfully. We hope to end the series by looking at *giving from the perspective of retirees* who may no longer have an active income.

**下届新加坡主教提名程序**

**特别议会 (Extraordinary Synod)**

自 2012 年起，潘仁义主教 (The Right Rev Rennis Ponniah) 为新加坡教区主教。他将在 2020 年 9 月 16 日退休。

教区法律顾问马格纳斯 (Richard Magnus)，通知议会将于 2019 年 11 月 8 至 9 日，在圣安德烈座堂召开特别议会，提名下届教区主教人选。东南亚教省拿督黄满兴大主教将为特别议会的讲员。

议会将用时间禁食，祷告，敬拜和聆听主的声音。将听取黄满兴大主教和潘仁义主教的指导，讨论教区接下来几年的需要，以及新一届主教的素质和资格。

每个牧师院和信徒院的成员，将在所属的院进行不记名提名最多两人作为人选考虑。圣希达堂的议会代表将参与提名的程序，他们是：

特别议会之后，法律顾问将召集大主教顾问团 (the Archbishop's Advisory Board)。只有教区法律顾

问和注册官会查看提名的结果，并在 2020 年 1 月结束前，将首三名呈报给教省主教院 (包含教省 4 位教区主教)。

教省主教院将面试候选人，经过慎重的祷告才做出最后的决定。在 2020 年 3 月，将向教区宣布推选的主教，给予潘仁义主教 5 到 6 个月的时间交棒。

**教牧指引**

法律顾问恳求教区，整个过程必须虔诚，使“神的殿永称为圣” (诗 93:5)，让我们的新主教为至高无上的拣选和任命 (诗 97:1)。

新加坡会吏长罗豫敬主教，在 2019 年 7 月 4 日也写信给所有牧师，女会吏和议会代表，对提名程序给予教牧指导。罗主教鼓励所有人参与：

1. 恳切祈求神拣选适合的人选。
2. 在特别议会前，11 月 8 日 (星期五) 禁食祷告。
3. 避免为任何人选劝说，拉票或者游说。
4. 提名敬畏神的人选。
5. 赞美神最后的结果，并且按主对我们的呼召，继续尽所能服事。

我请求所有圣希达堂的会友，遵照所给予的教牧指引，特别为教区将来的领导禁食，祷告，寻求神至高无上的旨意和目的。
