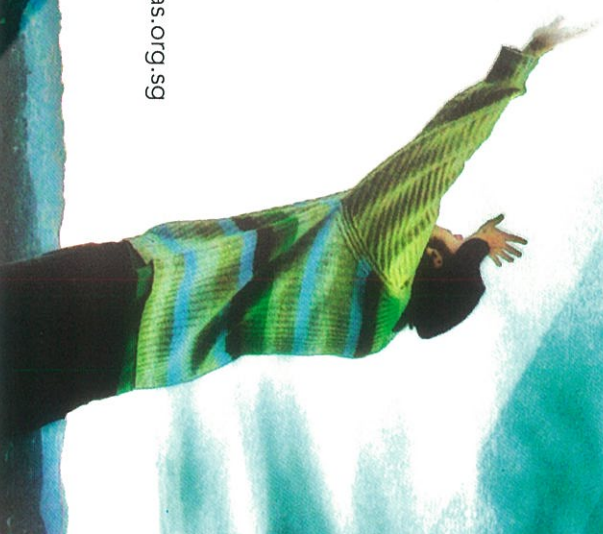

Dear friends,

You may remember that I was in Germany over two weekends recently. The reason of my trip was the health condition of my mother. Many of you have prayed for her and for me. Thank you very much for your prayers.

Allow us to briefly describe the situation. My mother is 92-years old. My father passed away 9 years ago. My mum continued to live by herself in the family home until she had a bad fall 4 years ago and needed to transfer into a nursing home. She has also been suffering from dementia for about 11 years now.

I am an only-child. Because of her Christian conviction, my mum was very glad to see us go into mission work in Singapore in 2004 and into pastoral ministry after that though it meant that we would live very far from her. By God's provision, a Methodist couple who is living near my mum started to support her with daily errands and doctors' visits after my dad's passing.

I have been visiting my mum around three times per year, usually for one week each time. In recent years, our oldest son, David, has shared this responsibility with me. Occasionally, we visited her with the whole family. This has been our way of looking after her despite the long distance.

My recent trip became necessary because my mother had rejected food and drink for three days. The nurses and the doctor had asked me to come. The good news is that she started eating and drinking again. But she lost her mobility and is now bed-ridden. According to the care-givers, these are signs that her body is slowly giving up. As much as I would like my mum to turn 93 next year, it looks unlikely that she will still be with us for Christmas. It would be wonderful if we could keep her company as much as possible during this final stage of her life on earth. This might mean that I will need to make another, shorter trip before Christmas and another one after Christmas if she still carries on.

We hope for your understanding and covet your prayers.
