STATEMENT FOR SUNDAY BULLETIN FIRE IN ST HILDA'S CHURCH

On Easter Sunday, a small room on Level 2 of our church building caught fire before our 8 a.m. E1 service.

The SCDF quickly put out the fire, which was confined to the room.

Used clothes, toys, and educational books stored in the room were destroyed in the fire, including furnishings and fittings.

Thankfully, the rest of the church building was unaffected. Nobody was hurt, and all church services proceeded as scheduled.

On Tuesday, 18 April, Yeo Liang Chai was charged in court with one count of mischief by fire. His case will be heard this coming Tuesday, 25 April.

Liang Chai, or LC as he is known, is our church member as well as church caretaker.

During this difficult time, I urge you to pray for Liang Chai and his family. The church is extending to them our prayers and support.

Liang Chai is our brother-in-Christ, and a dedicated and hardworking member of our staff. In the time we have known him, both as a volunteer and recently as a staff member, he has always tried to do what is best for the church.

This is the time to affirm our faith—the risen Christ has overcome all things, even sin and death. We may not understand why this happened but we know God is with us.

Please pray for Liang Chai at this difficult time. Let us stand united as one. May God be pleased and glorified in our response, in private as in public.
