Student Registration & Volunteer Teachers

Praise the Lord, we have registered more than **130 students** at CLC, exceeding our planned target of 100. These are students from the commune public schools. They are so eager to improve their English in our **English tuition classes, commencing in Jan 2018**. What a Christmas gift from our Father! And what a big starting workload for Constance and her four young local teachers!

Thank God, our sisters Pat Wee, Iris Yee and Sook Leng are going up to CLC in Svay Prahoot on 27th December to support Constance, with Pat staying for 2 months. Among other things, they will continue with training of the local teachers as well as teach in some of English classes themselves. Greatly appreciate their love and their contributions.

We would like to **appeal for more voluntary teachers** from SHC who can do short stints in CLC, staying a few weeks or months. When you go, you will be not only an encouragement to Constance and the local teachers, but also an invaluable teacher resource in CLC, as teachers from Singapore are highly regarded by Cambodians as good English speakers. You don't necessarily have to be ex-teachers. All lesson plans and teaching materials are provided, training and coaching too. **Board and lodging are provided** at our new, modern, well-equipped building. SHC's current policy is to pay airfare for volunteers going up for 30 days or more. Or, if you need airfare subsidy, please let us know.

Interested volunteers, please contact Sook Leng and Josephine Lee in the 8am Service, or Sonny, John Teo, Meng Choo, Chak in 10am Service. {Members from Mandarin congregation and E3 Service are most welcome as well}.

While English tuition classes for school children are our bread & butter programs, in the second half of 2018, Constance and teachers are planning to start "English Corners" once a week for the older children and young adults with basic English knowledge, especially our CCOR youth group, who want to improve their English conversational skills. In addition, our sister Meng Choo will lead "English Workshops for University and School Teachers", a 3-day program in CLC in Svay Prahoot. Our vision is to be a Centre of Excellence for English teaching in Svay Rieng Province.

We take this opportunity to thank all our SHC members for their generous donations to the Cambodian Education fund.
