From the Vicar's Office

Dear friends,

With 55 days to Celebration of Hope, we would like to outline how St Hilda's is getting ready for a joyful harvest.

It was a great joy to see more than 100 of us getting trained as Andrews, in church, in cell and at the central training. Please approach us if you would still like to receive the training. The essence of the training is to Pray, to Engage and to Gather, PEG. We pray for ourselves as well as for those that we want to engage with. We engage in natural ways, e.g. with colleagues at work, with people in the gym or with our family members. In conversations, we can ask for permission to share our life story and continue to pray for an opportunity to share the gospel. We have received the Andrew Cards and many of us have filled in a few names already. And as of this week, many banners draw attention to CoH along Ceylon and Marshall Road.

What's next? How do we gather?

We have planned for two 'seeker-friendly' Sundays over the next few weeks. Our services on those days will be Holy Communion services with a simple, encouraging sermon. On April 7, Rev Peter Cook from the Cathedral, will preach in E1 and E2. Rev Peter is very good in telling the gospel to people who have no background in Christianity. On April 21, we will joyfully celebrate the miracle of Easter as families in E1 and E2/3. We will present the gospel for children and adults alike. We encourage you to invite to these services those you are praying for. It serves as a preparation for the 'big' invitation for May 17-19. Those that you would like to invite for the evening rallies on May 17 and 19 can already hear the Good News on April 7 and 21. For the morning rally on May 18 for families with young children, April 21 is a great opportunity.

Let us all uphold these services in prayer and invite our friends!

Many of you will have noticed that we need more time on Sundays for announcements. We have been trying to be more mindful of how we use time. As a result, we have sometimes shortened the Holy Communion liturgy which many of us hold very dear. We ask for your gracious understanding as we continue to work on a well-balanced order for our services.

There have been many moments of Spirit-filled rejoicing in our church life over the past few months. Let us pray that this joy will increase as we move towards Celebration of Hope.
