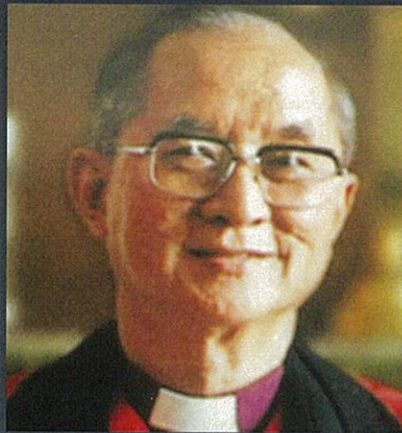

THE LATE BISHOP JOSHUA CHIU BAN IT

Bishop Joshua Chiu Ban It went home to the Lord on 9 Nov 2016. His wife Bek Neo, and children Michael, Veronica and Cheng were at his bedside. Bp Chiu was the 4th Vicar of St Hilda's Church from 1952-1955. He became the first Malayan-born Bishop of the Diocese of Singapore and Malaya in 1966. During his 16 years as Diocesan Bishop the Diocese experienced the touch of the Holy Spirit through the charismatic renewal. The St Hilda's Family fondly remembers Bp Chiu and his tremendous contribution to St Hilda's and the Diocese. We would like to extend our deepest condolences to Bp Chiu's family during this time of bereavement. Bp Chiu has fought the good fight, he has finished the race, he has kept the faith. May his soul rest in peace in the arms of His Master our Lord Jesus Christ.
