About Davy Liu

Founder of Kendu Films, Davy immigrated to the United States at the age of 13. He struggled through most of his academic years and tried to fit in the western culture at the same time. He found comfort in art and had won awards at the national level. At age 19, his artistic talent soon led him to work for Walt Disney Feature Animation on classic films such as "Beauty and the Beast," "Aladdin," "Mulan," and "The Lion King". He also worked for Warner Brothers on Space Jam and Quest of Camelot. In 1998, he worked for George Lucas at Industrial Light and Magic as art director and worked on Star Wars Episode I and Frankenstein. In year 2000, he was nominated as the most distinctive illustrator and his illustration has graced the pages of Business Week, Time Magazine, Wall Street Journal and The Super Bowl. Davy founded Kendu Films in 2004 and had since published the Invisible Tails series of picture books, namely "The Giant Leaf", "Fire Fish", "Jordan's Guest", "The Royal Feast" and "Enchanted Tree". While famed for his work in The Lion King, he realized the importance of using his talent for the King of kings. He came to understand: success in winning one soul has everlasting value in heaven worth more than a million Oscars on Earth.
