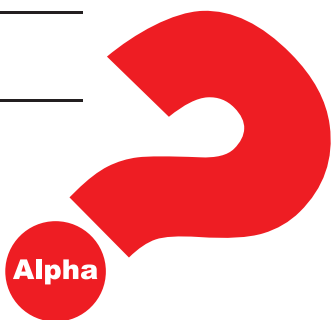
Every year an invitation goes out to the nation to come and explore the big issues of life on Alpha.
