UPDATE ON SVAY RIENG EDUCATION CENTRE & MULTIPURPOSE BUILDNG ("ECMB") AS AT 25TH APRIL 2017

- 1. Since the last update on 15th February 2017, the ECMB has changed it pitched (slanting) roof to a flat roof design. See picture below. A flat roof reduces the height of the building by some 16 feet, and makes the structure less prominent in a flat landscape of rice fields all around. A flat roof also yields more usable space as people can use the roof top, especially for leisure and relaxation purpose.
- 2. The flat roof will cost about USD 10,500 more as it requires the construction of an additional concrete slab like the 1st, 2nd and 3rd floor. The roof top will be water-proofed and covered with clay floor tiles.
- 3. Piping of water lines, electrical wiring and outfitting of lighting, fans, bathroom and toilet fixtures for the 1st, 2nd and 3rd floors are in process, including hot water for showers in the bathrooms. Fans and air-bricks are provided to give good ventilation.
- 4. With improvement in layout design on the 2nd floor, we can now comfortably house 30 persons for our teaching staff and longer-term missionaries from SHC, in additional to a 2-room pastoral apartment.
- 5. By God's grace, the ECMB will be an aesthetic and functionally efficient building when completed and outfitted by August 2017. The total four floors will yield a usable space of over 12,000 square feet.





- 6. The building fund donation has now reached SGD 225,000 out of the target of SGD 300,000. The completed building with improvements and other non-building related items like fencing and pavement of the muddy ground around the building will likely bring final total cost to SGD 380,000. The excess of SGD 80,000 may have to come out of SHC's reserves.
- 7. A generous SHC member has donated 287 new tables, and 550 chairs for the seven classrooms and worship-multipurpose hall and 20 beds for the apartments. We appeal to SHC members to further give to the building fund to complete the SGD 300,000 target.
- 8. In parallel with the "hardware "(building), the team is also working on the "software" programs for community work. More details on this will be given in the next update.
- 9. Please continue to pray SHC's work in Svay Rieng that God's name will be exalted and many lives saved.
