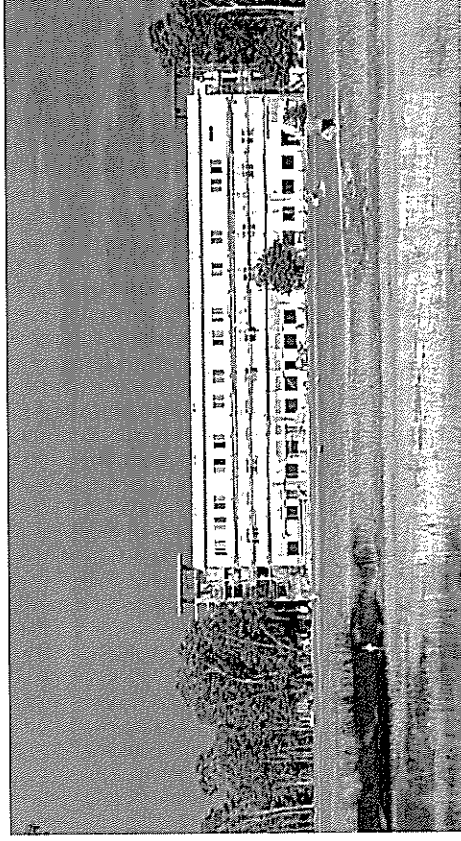

HAC Dedication Service 26th Oct,
Consecration of the Redeveloped CCOP 27th Oct,
and ACC 25th Anniversary Celebration Service
28th Oct 2018 in Cambodia

HAC Building in CCOR Compound, Svay Prahoot



Bishop Rennis will be conducting a dedication service for our new building in Svay Prahoot, the Hope Anglican Centre (HAC), on Friday 26th October 2018, 2.00-4.30pm. After the dedication service, all attendees will return to Phnom Penh the same day.

The next day, Saturday 27th October, would be the Consecration of the redeveloped Church of the Lord Jesus Christ Our Peace (CCOP) in Phnom Penh by Bishop Rennis.

On 28th October a special Sunday Service will be conducted in CCOP to celebrate the 25th Anniversary of the Anglican Church of Cambodia (ACC).

We encourage SHC Cambodian mission goers and members to attend the HAC dedication on the 26th Oct. You are also warmly invited to attend the CCOP dedication and the 25th ACC anniversary celebration, if you so wish .

For the HAC dedication, SHC will provide land transport to and from Phnom Penh and HAC, Svay Prahoot. However, SHC mission goers and members will have to pay their own air fares to Cambodia, hotel stay and other incidental expenses except for meals at dedication and anniversary ceremonies. If you are planning to go, you are advised to arrive in Phnom Penh one day earlier on the 25th October, stay the night in Phnom Penh and leave early the next day for Svay Prahoot. Otherwise, if you depart Singapore on 26th October, it would be by the first Silkair flight from Singapore arriving Phnom Penh airport at about 9.30am, and you proceed immediately from the airport to HAC, Svay Prahoot, a 3.5-hour car/bus journey, which will be arranged by SHC.

Chak SC, Jenny Chak and Catherine Teo will help to coordinate your hotel bookings in Phnom Penh at two designated hotels, Kolab Sor and Golden Gate (USD 30 double occupancy). We will block book the hotel rooms in advance, so please let Chak / Jenny / Catherine know the number of hotel room/s you require, whether attending services on 27th and 28th October and duration of your stay as well as your flight numbers once you have booked your flights.

Hope to see many of you all supporting the HAC dedication on 26th October as well as the CCOP dedication and 25th ACC Anniversary on 27th and 28th October respectively.
