As we get older, it becomes even more important that we warm up, stretch slowly and strengthen for the day ahead. Whether in a wheelchair or without; whether sitting down or standing up.

To coach us are two very experienced physiotherapists who have kindly agreed to help us with this **hands-on** session. **Please come dressed in comfortable attire.** You may bring along an assistant, if needed, to also learn the finer points of each exercise.

You will be caringly put through each exercise by Balachandran Sai Ram Kumar and Ms Rujuta Parmanand. They come highly recommended by Sister Linda Chee who has been a client since 2014 and Brother Colin Chee since late last year.

Sai has a Master's degree in Musculoskeletal Physiotherapy from the University of South Australia, Adelaide. Formerly with SGH, Sai has been living and practicing in Singapore for the past 16 years. He owns and operates Synergy Physiotherapy and Sports, with a branch on Bukit Timah Road and, in the past few months, a new branch on East Coast Road. He regularly delivers work injury prevention talks to corporates in Singapore and has a keen interest in the prevention and management of work-related musculoskeletal disorders.

Rujuta also has a Master's degree in Musculoskeletal Physiotherapy from the University of Mumbai. She has more than 10 years' experience working in Singapore treating an extensive range of acute and chronic orthopaedic/musculoskeletal injuries, sports injuries and post-operative rehabilitation. Rujuta has a specific interest in managing back and neck pain with individualized and customized treatment protocols. In Singapore, this Sunday (7 Oct 2018) is a day of National Fasting and Prayer for the shalom (peace and total well-being) of the nation. And the Lord will show Himself “mighty to save” for all who put their hope in His steadfast love (Ps 147:11; Is 35:4). This is true for every nation. The Church embodies and shares the hope we have in Christ Jesus.

Therefore, let all of us across our Diocese especially uphold before the Lord both Singapore and Sulawesi (Indonesia) in our prayers.

The Lord be with you, and mobilise us together in prayer and practical service to make His glory known.

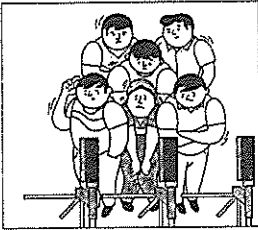

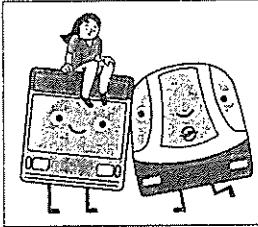
1 PLEASE ARRIVE EARLY

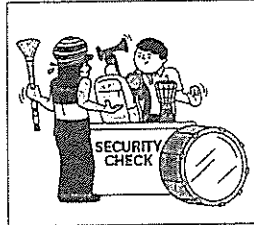
2 SMART MOVE: TAKE PUBLIC TRANSPORT

No jams. No parking woes. Nearest MRT stations: Stadium CC6 and Kallang EW10.



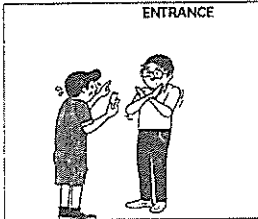
6 NO HELMETS, WEAPONS, FLARES, AIRHORNS & MUSICAL INSTRUMENTS PLEASE

Such items can injure or cause public nuisance.



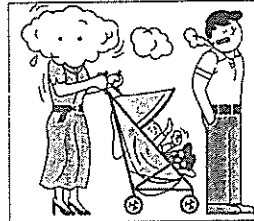
3 NO RE-ENTRY

Your ticket is only valid for a one-time entry into the stadium. You won't be allowed back in after you have exited the venue.



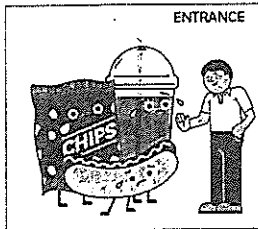
7 NO SMOKING PLEASE

Humans need fresh air. Singaporeans love fresh air. We want everyone to have a pleasant time.



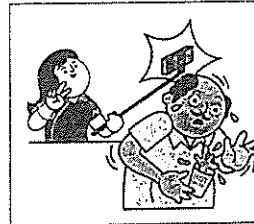
4 NO OUTSIDE FOOD & DRINKS

This is a Day of Prayer with Fasting. You are encouraged to fast. Enjoy a free bottle of mineral water, compliments of PraySingapore.



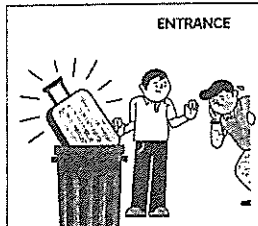
8 NO SELFIE STICKS PLEASE
