THE *Meeting* PLACE

"A biblical approach to Chinese Traditions and Beliefs"

This talk will examine aspects of various Chinese cultural practices and beliefs and their implications on our everyday lives as Christians. Is it okay to kneel to our grandparents and parents during weddings? Is it okay to hold joss sticks during funeral wakes? Is acupuncture okay for us as Christians? Or are these practices sinful in the context of Christianity? There are so many conflicting and controversial views on the matter. Would you like some clarity and understanding on what we can or cannot do? Come and learn more about the biblical teachings and principles which can help us evaluate the acceptability or not of such practices, beliefs and cultural norms.

Our Speaker is Canon Daniel Tong, currently Vicar of St Andrew's Community Chapel. Canon Tong is a graduate of the Trinity Theological College, and has been a priest in the Anglican Diocese of Singapore since 1993. Canon Tong is married with three children. He is the author of these books – *A Biblical Approach to Chinese Traditions and Beliefs*, *A Biblical Approach to Feng Shui and Divination*, *Praying Right*, and more recently, *Law & Grace: Salvation, Sin and Good Work in the Christian Life*.
