## **How To Fire Up Your Brain Circuitry For Hope And Optimism**

There are times in our lives when we, like Job and King David feel that all have deserted us, seemingly abandoned even by God. King David felt this way many times. In Psalms 22:1 he cries, “My God, my God, why have you forsaken me? Why are you so far from saving me...?”

During those trying times it was their faith that kept them whole. Whether you want to bounce back or simply build up resilience to avoid despair and depression, come and listen to how God heals by activating our brain’s love circuits

Neuroscience has discovered the workings of the parts of the brain that trigger "hope and optimism" which also calm other parts of the brain responsible for anxiety, fear and depression. This research reveals how we are already wired to overcome fear through the workings of love as found in the Bible promise that "perfect love casts out fear" (1John 4:18).

Our speaker is Mr Yip Kok Tho. He is Chairman of Aenon, a non-profit medical lifestyle modification centre in Malaysia for over 16 years. Before he retired in 2003, he was the Chief Financial Officer of various American MNCs and the SMRT.
