## Vicar's Pastoral Letter

5 March 2017

Rev David Lee has been a great blessing to St Hilda's Church since Bishop Rennis Ponniah posted him to us on 1 October 2013. In his time with St Hilda's Rev David was able to build lasting relationships with our church members. He has been my able and faithful right hand when my Diocesan duties have drawn me away from you. He has also been our go-to person for the many church initiatives that have transformed our church in these past three years.

In January this year we were informed of the Bishop's intention for Rev David to take a sabbatical from 11 March to 30 June 2017, with the view that he will be posted to another parish in the Anglican family on 1 October 2017. He is planning for another priest of a similar experience level to join us in St Hilda's on 1 October.

There has been a process of discussion and feedback between the Vicar, St Hilda's Parish Church Council (PCC) and the Diocesan Bishop. A delegation of the PCC met Bishop Rennis on 11 February to share our perspective and concerns, and to seek his reconsideration.

Bishop Rennis shared with me on 26 February that he appreciated the feedback from our delegation. He has prayed over the matter, and received the assurance of the Lord that the sabbatical and posting plan was His will and should proceed. He also reiterated to me his certainty in faith that the vision from the Lord that he shared with St Hilda's during our 82<sup>nd</sup> Anniversary Celebration in November 2016—a vision of buckets overflowing with water, bring life everywhere we go—will come to pass despite this change.

On my part, the Lord has been re-shaping my ministry responsibilities over the past 7 months.

For Cambodia, the Lord has placed it on the heart of my Associate Dean, the Rev Steven Seah, to inform the Bishop in August 2016 that he was willing to be based full-time in Cambodia. Since Rev Seah moved to Cambodia on 19 November 2016, he has relieved significantly my responsibility as the Dean of Cambodia.

For the Chapel of Christ the Redeemer (CCR), where I have been Acting Vicar since April 2014, I have had the privilege of seeing Pastor Joshua Raj grow as a parish worker to be ordained as a deacon in May 2016. Since February 2017, he has expressed his readiness to fully lead the ministry. My role in CCR remains only in the chairing of the PCC meeting.

These are signs that the Lord has already rearranged my plate to allow me to devote the bulk of my time and energy to St Hilda's, so that we can continue to grow in worship, pastoral care, discipleship and leadership development, evangelism and missions, both local and overseas.

We will have an opportunity during our worship service on 12 March to pray for Rev David and his family as he embarks on his sabbatical. He will still be with us from July to September before his posting on 1 October.

While we will surely miss Rev David, let us also rejoice with him that the fruits of his ministry among us will endure. Let us look to the Lord, and continue the good work that He has given to us, for indeed "(Paul) planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the growth." (1 Cor 3:6 ESV).

The Lord who has blessed us with David is still the same good God who will give us His abundant grace to continue growing and serving Him for His glory.
