In Exodus 23, God gave specific instructions on seasons and days that are to be set aside to the service of God, for example, the laws on the Sabbath year and the Sabbath day. There are also instructions on the celebration of three great annual pilgrimage feasts, the Feast of Unleavened Bread, the Feast of Harvest or Weeks and the Feast of Ingathering. The lectures will look at the Biblical Cycle of Seasons and Festivals in Exodus 23, how it was celebrated by Jesus and what is their prophetic meaning and significance and how they are celebrated today, and how God's eternal timetable is revealed through these appointed days. We will look especially at the Jubilee, its meaning and purpose, and the role of Sh'mitah - which has become a significant issue in certain Christian circles recently.
