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

HOW TO SEARCH AND BORROW BOOKS

a) Electronic Search

- 1. On your own computer or smart phone, go to shclibrary1.librarika.com
- 2. Ignore Member Login
- 3. To "Search Catalog" type any part of the book title or author's name into the "keyword field" and click "Search"
- 4. When the book title appears on the screen, click the Book Title and it will open up a 'description of the book'; scroll down to the end to obtain the "Accession Number" (i.e. Catalog Number for you to locate the book on the shelves)
- 5. "Library Resources" allows you to search the catalog in different ways. E.g. "Database A-Z" provides a key board screen to list the first alphabet of the book title. Click the Book Title and it will open up a 'description of the book'; scroll down to the end to obtain the "Accession Number" for you to locate the book on the shelves.

b) Manual Search

There are several paper catalogs in the library that will assist you in your search.

To **Borrow Books**, please provide the following details in the paper folder in the library: your name, tel. no, date out, name of book, book/catalog number & your signature. You are allowed to borrow up to 3 books for 2 months.

To **Return Books**, please return all books @ the Drop Box in the Church Office.
