

MEMORY VERSE (Nov. 2019)

"I tell you the truth, no servant is greater than his master, nor is a messenger greater than the one who sent him. Now that you know these things, you will be blessed if you do them."

John 13:16-17 (NIV)



Nestled in the seaside town of Whitby in Northeast England in the 7th century AD stood Whitby Abbey whose founding abbess was a Christian princess named Hilda.



From the time she answered her call to be a nun at the age of 33, until her promotion to glory at the age of 66, Hilda energetically established schools and Christian faith communities in the Celtic spiritual tradition.

Abbess Hilda ministered to many people in the Hartlepool and Whitby area, encouraging young people to use their gifts for the glory of God. Her zeal for education inspired a young shepherd boy

named Caedmon to become an accomplished Christian poet.

The Synod of Whitby in AD664 was convened in Whitby Abbey. The hospitality of Abbess Hilda opened a fountain of grace that enabled church leaders from diverse traditions to come to an amicable agreement on issues such as when Easter should be celebrated.

Today in Whitby stands **St Hilda's Priory** (pictured above), the home of the **Order of the Holy Paraclete**. This order of Anglican sisters was founded in 1915 to provide education to the children in **St Hilda's School**, **Whitby**.

It is very likely that our Founder Archdeacon Graham White was familiar with St Hilda's School and Priory, because from 1920-1925, he was the Vicar of the Church of St Hilda and St Helen in Dawdon Colliery, just 75km north of Whitby.

It is no wonder that in 1934, the Archdeacon named the new church and school he founded: St Hilda's Church and School, Katong, Singapore.

In celebration of the 85th Anniversary of St Hilda's Church and Schools this year, we have the joy of welcoming Sister Dorothy and Sister Anita to visit us from the Order of the Holy Paraclete.

Sisters Dorothy and Anita will be presenting a short seminar at St Hilda's Church, Sanctuary, on Sunday 10 November 2019, 1:30-3:00pm on:

"The Life and Inspiration of Saint Hilda of Whitby".

They will be sharing **stories** of our patron saint, and the way that she and the Christians blessed the church and the society at that time.





The Sisters will also be sharing their ministry experiences as teachers and pastors, both in Ghana, Africa, and in England. Most importantly, we will learn how the **living tradition and spirituality of St Hilda** has inspired and sustained their own passion for God and service to the needy over many years.

Set aside time to learn from our dear Sisters, to follow the faith example of St Hilda in becoming lifelong disciples and faithful servants of Christ as we "seek the welfare of the city" (Jeremiah 29:7).
