- Pray for all Christians in Singapore to honour God in all of their lives and to be loving and kind towards their neighbours.

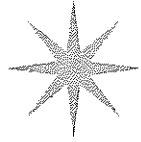
## World

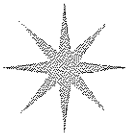
