Dear St Hilda's Family,

Blessings to you and your loved ones in the name of our Risen Lord Jesus!

I am writing to inform you about exciting changes at St Hilda's. We have plans of starting a new service on Saturday afternoon that will take the place of our current E3 and SES services.

We started SES during the time of Covid to make our services available to more worshippers when numbers were limited to 50. It has since developed into a service of a more quiet and reflective style with 50-60 faithful worshippers. We thank God for all who have stepped up to serve in SES. However, there is a lack of volunteers which means that staff and at times members of our other services are helping to sustain SES.

E3 was moved to Saturday during Covid as well, similar to SES, as a response to pandemic restrictions, however with a different style that would appeal to our youth and young adults and with a separate youth ministry program that takes place after service. It is a vibrant service with 40-55 faithful worshippers. While we find a dedicated group of younger people who have been serving wholeheartedly, the lack of a children's ministry during the service has not allowed opportunities for the service to meet the needs of congregants beyond a certain life stage. With a longer-term perspective, it would eventually prohibit the growth of the service, in particular as our E3 congregants are moving into the life stage of working adults.

The New Saturday Service will be a service for all generations. It will be vibrant, and different in style compared to E1 and E2, yet with an Anglican format. It will be a time of worshipping God with much joy and devotion, of listening to God's Word, with Spirit-filled ministry
