龚招光牧师，他原籍砂拉越古晋，早年为一名土地测量师。他的师母潘淑丽，她是一名教师，他们育有三名孩子。他于1989年投入全职事奉；分别在砂劳越和新加坡三一神学院接受神学教育。毕业后，他在诸圣堂华文堂事奉(1996-1999)，负责青年事工、中国人事工和圣公会中学的校牧事工。之后，他被调派到善牧堂华文堂(2000-2004)负责青年事工、双语崇拜和社区外展事工。龚牧师于2004年和2005年被按立成为会吏和会长之后，就被调派去马林百列基督教会担任华文堂牧师(2005-2009)。接着，他被调派到圣公会关怀中心（后港和义顺）开拓和发展心理健康院牧事工(2010-2020)，同时担任义顺基督教会的义务牧师。2020年被受委圣约翰堂华文堂牧师，并于2022年6月受委为真光堂华文堂牧师。招光牧师有很多个人爱好，例如阅读、看电影和纪录片、做家务、欣赏大自然、美术、音乐、舞蹈表演和浸濡于其他国家的文化。
