#### Dear St Hilda's Family,

Archdeacon Graham White and his wife Georgina left us the wonderful legacy of church and educational ministry for St Hilda's Church. I thank God that we have been faithful to continue the ministry for 89 years, and I am confident of this that he who began the good work in [us] will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus.



From January 2024, preschool our ministry will enter into a new season. Our 83 Ceylon Rd campus has been beautifully renovated to start as a childcare centre. Children from 18 months up to K2 age will receive day-long educational care with the same Christian principles that St Hilda's is known for. Our gospel ministry to children, parents and teachers will continue through our chaplaincy worker, Ps Steven Tan, Ms Sheila Buckland, a group of Christian teachers and church volunteers

The change to childcare became necessary as the government continues to encourage all operators to switch to this model which allows both parents to work and receive subsidized childcare. It has been hastened by the fast-changing preschool landscape. Since 2014, MOE has started 43 kindergartens in primary schools with plans to add 17 more in the next few years. Anglican Preschool Services (APS) has therefore decided to pivot all kindergartens to childcare centres.

The new centre will continue to offer a kindergarten-like model in addition to childcare for parents who prefer their children to come home in the afternoon. We are praying that many of our existing parents will welcome the change.

Almost all SHK staff have accepted APS' offer to work in the new centre.



Opening the new childcare centre means that the regular preschool ministry will be located in 83 Ceylon Rd. APS is still committed to using the 41 Ceylon Rd campus and is praying that strong enrolment will soon require the additional space. Until then, they will use 41 Ceylon Rd as a flexi venue and – in time to come – will carry out renovations to prepare the spaces for childcare operations.

The financial contributions from APS to St Hilda's Church remain unchanged.

We will celebrate SHK Sunday on October 29 at E1+2. It's a day to celebrate our preschool ministry and to appreciate and pray for the teachers. Children will perform songs in each service.



Lord, look upon all those who are suffering with Your compassion. Save us Lord, and help them those who are helpless. In the precious Name of our Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ. Amen.

May the Lord guide you by His Holy Spirit as you remember Gaza and Israel in your prayers.
