Dear St Hilda's Family,

Over the past few weeks, we have informed you of our plans to change the Bible translation that we have been using for our pew Bibles and for the readings in our services. We are planning to change from the "New International Version" (NIV) to the "English Standard Version" (ESV).

As promised, here are the main reasons why we will pursue this change:

We need to replace our pew Bibles

Our pew Bibles in the Church Sanctuary are 25-30 years old. We had to remove them during Covid and store them in boxes. If we were to put them back, many of them would look mouldy and tattered.

Even though we are in the digital age and have access to the Bible on our phones, I am still committed to bringing back pew Bibles.

The version of our pew Bibles is no longer available

Our pew Bibles are the NIV 1984 edition. This edition is no longer available. It has been superseded by the NIV 2011 edition. The new edition is substantially different from the old.

The NIV 2011 edition has made a deliberate effort to become genderneutral

Every Bible translation is undertaken by a group of scholars and linguists and financed by a publishing house. And every translation needs to strike a balance between accuracy and readability; a word-byword translation is hardly readable. The NIV is known to strike a good balance. However, the 2011 translation has shifted significantly towards gender-neutral language where the original text uses the masculine. Examples for this are 'he' \rightarrow 'they', 'man' \rightarrow 'mankind', 'forefathers' \rightarrow 'ancestors', etc. Depending on our convictions, we consider such alterations a more or less serious matter.

The NIV 2011 edition is less accessible

Though this version is the best-seller around the world, it is – to my knowledge – not accessible offline in free Apps.

There are many alternative translations available. Why have we decided to change to ESV?

Accuracy: The ESV is regarded by many scholars as the most accurate translation.

Accessibility: The ESV is freely available offline in the Crossway Bible App.

<u>Alignment:</u> Many of the Anglican parishes in Singapore, including our Cathedral use ESV.

The ESV also has an excellent Study-Bible and many respected commentaries.



There is still time to join a bulk order for large-print, hard-cover ESV Bibles at \$30 per Bible. We will consolidate and place the order by the end of January. Kindly let the church office know. Delivery will take around four weeks. We will implement the change once the new Bibles arrive.

The most important aspect is not which translation of the Bible we use but whether we read it regularly and accept it as God-given authority over our life. Let us keep his statutes!


