## **World**

- Pray for Myanmar & Vietnam as the nations cope with tropical storms. Pray that emergency and disaster relief workers will be able to manage the injured, locate the missing, and comfort families of those who have perished in the disaster.
- Thank God that injuries and fatalities were kept to a minimum as Typhoon Bebinca swept through Shanghai. Praise God for power having been restored by Tuesday midnight and Bebinca has been downgraded to a tropical storm as it sweeps inland.
