- We pray for God's continued protection of the Church, even St Hilda's Church from becoming a place of infection, except for the Gospel and the love of Christ!

The Vicar Writes ...

Psalm 13

How long, Lord? Will you forget me forever?
How long will you hide your face from me?

Dear St Hilda's Family,

It was my intention to write to you this week to clarify our approach to making our onsite services accessible to more worshippers. But circumstances have changed in unexpected ways.

The Lord has placed the burden on my heart to call us to pray fervently for the situation in our nation, for our schools and for our response to the spread of infection.

We need to pray for comfort for the bereaved family and for the assailant and his family. Much criticism is placed on that family and the school counsellors. Instead, we shall pray for and show the love of Christ to those, even if there may have been mistakes in judgement.

The stress on our school leaders, teachers, counsellors and chaplains is enormous right now. The fear of copy-cat attacks and other acts of violence, even self-harm is weighing heavy on them. This is made even more difficult when staff is being placed on QOs or SHNs because of exposure alerts. Our own St Hilda's Kindergarten is experiencing a shortage of teachers right now.

We need to pray for our schools that God will strengthen the leadership teams. We need to pray against the spirit of fear to paralyze our schools and against self-doubts rising among teachers, counsellors and chaplains. May God remind them of their calling and of his presence and continue to provide his abundant wisdom and shalom peace.

The spread of Covid has brought us back to P2HA which has been a great disappointment for many. Another call to all of us to stay home and stay safe. How long still, oh Lord? (Ps 13) We need to pray that our government will take wise decisions and that the population is willing to follow.

Let us also pray that the Lord will build a hedge around St Hilda's Church, our kindergarten, our community services and our schools to protect us from any outbreaks of Covid-19. May he protect his Church from becoming clusters so that the name of the Lord and his people shall not be tarnished.

The devil is launching an attack against the emotional fabric of our nation. Fear, anger, prejudice, and hatred is rising against people who frequent KTV launches (there are many in our neighborhood), hostesses from Vietnam and the Philippines, people with mental illnesses. As Christians, we can entrust these emotions to our Heavenly Father. On a national level, we need to pray against the powers of darkness and – as Church – be a beacon of light, bringing the love of Christ to all.

As many of us are lost for words, it was also not easy for me to write this letter. We can take comfort that when we pray to our Father, we don't need to use perfectly crafted words. He perceives our thoughts from afar (Ps 139) and he inclines his ear because of his great love for us. In a time like this, let us lift our voices to the Lord and trust in his unfailing love, rejoicing in his salvation! (Ps 13)

As for our worship services during P2HA, we continue to celebrate services for max 50 worshippers on Saturday 2pm (E3), 5pm (SES) and on Sunday 8am (E1), 10:15am (E2), and 10:30am (Mandarin).

Online Holy Communion service is on Saturday 5pm, online non-HC service is available on YouTube on Sunday from 8am. We encourage non-vaccinated seniors to worship from home. We are happy to bring Holy Communion to you at home!
