Practical Application: Warfare in Three Arenas

Spiritual warfare is not just an abstract concept; it is the daily discipline of **standing firm** where God has placed you. Here are concrete examples of how to apply the armour and the plan in your three most critical arenas:

1. In the Family (The Arena of Intimacy)

Spiritual Attack (The Lie)	Warfare Action (The Truth)	Armor Applied
Division/Bitterness: The lie that family conflicts are just personality clashes, leading to unforgiveness.	Pray and Proclaim: Intercede daily for your spouse/children by name, asking for the fruits of the Spirit. When conflict arises, verbally state the truth: "I am forgiven in Christ, so I choose to forgive."	Breastplate of Righteousness (forgives others because you are forgiven) and Sword of the Spirit (speaking truth).
Discouragement/Fear: The lie that you are a failure as a parent or spouse.	Stand Firm: Anchor your thoughts in your identity. Confess God's promise that "He who began a good work in you will bring it to completion" (Phil 1:6).	Helmet of Salvation (assurance of future hope) and Shield of Faith (trusting His promises).

2. In the Workplace (The Arena of Influence)

Spiritual Attack (The Lie)	Warfare Action (The Truth)	Armor Applied
Pride/Covetousness: The lie that your self-worth depends on status, salary, or competition with colleagues.	Look Up: Make prayer your first act upon arrival. Specifically pray against the spirit of rivalry and for your colleagues' eternal well-being.	Belt of Truth (work is service to Christ, not a measure of worth) and Prayer at All Times .
Unjust Actions: The temptation to gossip, cut corners, or engage in dishonesty for professional gain.	Stand Firm/Proclaim: Refuse to participate. Let your consistency and integrity be your silent proclamation of the Gospel.	Shoes of Peace (provides stability in conflict) and Breastplate of Righteousness (committing to moral integrity).

3. In the Church (The Arena of Unity)

Spiritual Attack (The Lie)	Warfare Action (The Truth)	Armor Applied
Criticism/Division: The lie that you must choose a side in a church disagreement or that minor doctrinal points should break fellowship.	Intercede: Pray specifically for unity and for the leaders of the church (as Paul requested). Refuse to spread gossip; address issues directly and in love (Matthew 18).	Shield of Faith (believing God's ability to protect the body) and Intercession for all the saints .
Apathy/Inertia: The lie that your small role doesn't matter or that mission is someone else's responsibility.	Proclaim: Ask God for boldness to invite someone to worship or serve alongside you. Actively share how Christ has worked in your life this week.	Sword of the Spirit (actively proclaiming the Gospel) and Courageously Proclaim Christ .

Vicar writes....

"Oh come, let us worship and bow down; let us kneel before the Lord, our Maker!"
(Psalm 95:6)

Dear St Hilda's Family,

Blessings to you and your loved ones! We give thanks to the Lord for our sermon series through the book of Ephesians where Paul reminds us to work towards the unity of the Spirit with all humility, gentleness and love for one another. (Ephesians 4:2-3)

It has been almost three months that we started our new 10.15 service. I would like to thank all who have been serving faithfully every week. It has been a big change for many but your commitment to serving the Lord and his church has been unwavering. Thank you very much!

Our services are providing a spiritual home for a diverse group of worshippers, in age and in preference of worship style. At the same time, the Lord has blessed us with a diversity of gifts and is calling us to offer these gifts unto him.

Over the next few weeks, I will be writing to you with a threefold call: a call for reverence, for unity, and for service.

I will begin with a call for reverence.

We all want to give all honor to God and enable our brothers and sisters to give their undivided attention to the Lord. We have therefore given instructions to our hospitality teams to ask those who are arriving late for service to kindly wait in the entrance area during the time of Confession & Absolution and during the reading of Scripture. These are very solemn moments in our service where we want to reduce movement in the hall to a minimum out of reverence for the Lord. Starting this week, we will make two rows at the back of Bethel Hall available where those who are arriving late can conveniently find your seats. It is important for us as a community to develop an understanding in love for those who come late because you will have good reasons for being late, and we are glad that you want to join in worship, still. But we appeal to your understanding to enter the hall with reverence.

Another solemn moment in our service is the celebration of Holy Communion. It is both, a deep personal encounter with God and a wonderful expression of communal worship. In more traditional churches, people would kneel all throughout, spending time in prayer. You can hear a needle drop on the floor. In St Hilda's Church, we love the celebration of Holy Communion,

and we sometimes make it a very communal moment, especially after we have received the elements. While others are still coming forward, we greet our friends on our way back to the seat, checking in and even chatting with them. This joyful expression of community can affect others who wish to focus on the Lord in a quiet time of prayer.

Allow me to suggest that the Lord has given us the Manna House where we can spend time with one another in joyful fellowship *after the service*. Let us make use of God's provision and maintain reverence during the celebration of Holy Communion.

A short note to those of us with young children. An intergenerational service certainly includes your children, especially after they return from Sunday School. Children express themselves in different ways, and we cannot expect that they behave in the same way as adults. Children bring joy in their innocence. Bringing them up to be perfectly behaved in a church service is super-hard. May I encourage you – in love – to teach your children to add to the reverence of the community during these solemn moments.

In closing, may I appeal to all of us to encourage one another and to be slow to criticise. Those who serve give their best and deserve our encouragement. Let us put forth humility, gentleness and love for the sake of the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.
