Dear St Hilda's Family,

Greetings in the name of Jesus on this 1st Advent weekend!

We have been looking at messianic Bible passages since October and will take encouragement from Isaiah's 'Servant'-passages during Advent.

Covid-19 is still requiring us to be in constant prayer. Thank God for the first signs of easing of the medical situation in our nation after many concerning weeks. The government has responded swiftly with further re-opening. We are again allowed to sit and fellowship in groups of 5. Zones in churches will change from 50 to 100, though the cap of 50 remains for services where not everybody is fully vaccinated.

Crucially, the government is working on the resumptions of more activities in a safe manner for seniors. We have always regarded attending church services, on-site or from home – as an essential part of our life. Our staff team and volunteers have been working hard to make our services as safe as possible, the Lord being our helper!

We have therefore decided to invite our 60+ year old members to resume serving in church on an opt-in basis. If you are in this age-group, please consider prayerfully if you would like to serve again. You will be warmly welcomed back!

Looking forward toward Advent and Christmas, we are excited to announce several services that can be celebrated on-site and from home. In church, these services will be open for those of us who are fully vaccinated. Those who are not yet fully vaccinated, can still attend on-site if you present a negative test result upon entry.

As for our regular services, E1 will continue to be for the fully vaccinated, only. E2 will follow from Dec 12 onward. We will scale up the seating capacity in E2 as we look forward to members returning. SES will remain capped at 50, allowing our vaccinated and non-vaccinated members to worship together.

Like in many previous letters, I am focussing much on safe management measures. I am looking so much forward to a time when the full attention of our team will be on making disciples of all nations and on caring for our people with the love of Jesus. Let us pray together that this will be possible in 2022!
