ROOF REPLACEMENT – PROJECT UPDATE

Roof Works

1. The 70-year-old roof of the L- shaped annexe building was given a waterproofing makeover in 2016 and its 5-year warranty has since expired. Several leaks have been detected in the past 2 years and an expert review has recommended the replacement of the 70-year-old roof tiles.
2. Tong Seng Huat Engrg Pte Ltd has been appointed as the main contractor. They have worked with SHC on the Sanctuary roof replacement.



1st Phase

3. Re-roofing works will commence on 30th May in 2 phases. The following facilities will be closed.
 - Church/Pastoral office (30th May to 15th June)
 - Meeting Room/Cradle Club Rm 210 (30th June to 15th June)



2nd Phase

- Daniel Room (13th June to 15th July)
 - Manna House (11th June to 15th July)
4. During the closure, the office will be relocated.
 5. During this period, parking in the Courtyard will be limited and members are advised to park in the carpark behind

Landscaping Works

8. Except for the trees in the courtyard, the fruits of the other trees are no longer accessible. The fruits of the trees in the courtyard are often worm- and insect-infested.



9. The trees have caused many issues over the years. They attract birds (many crows), bats, mosquitoes, red ants, possibly even termites. The fruits and the zap, bird and bat droppings are a hazard to the kindergarten children, pedestrian, and to cars.
10. The roots of several trees have grown into the drainages and caused damage to the courtyard carpark. They also pose a risk to the wooden decks behind Manna House and the classrooms.



11. There is a small but detrimental risk of falling branches during a storm.
12. The maintenance of the trees is costly. They need to be trimmed every 3-5 years. The current rate is around \$10,000 to trim all trees.
13. The Property & Maintenance committee has spoken to those who have planted the trees. PCC has taken the decision on 24th May to remove the trees.
14. The Property & Maintenance committee will engage a landscaping company for options and advice on new trees, hedges or shrubs that can be planted. Members are welcome to contribute their ideas.
