VICAR'S ADDRESS

Dear St Hilda's Church Family,

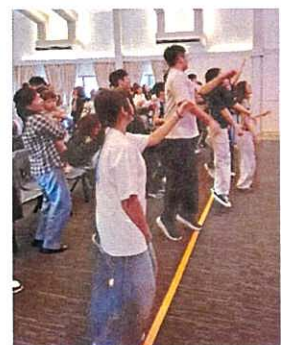
As I was writing this report, I found it difficult to find a tone that would follow on from our 90th anniversary year in 2024. A church camp in Penang with two bishops, a Parish of the Week campaign, a wonderful celebration at the EXPO with 41 confirmation candidates. How could 2025 compare? Then, the Lord reminded me that this is not a newspaper article to highlight the top events in our parish life. My report should focus on him who works in our lives and in the life of his church, in the big events and in the small but deep moments whenever we spend time with him.

We asked the Lord that 2025 would be a year where we grow in unity and in our identity as an Anglican worshipping community. Ephesians 4:4-6 is a wonderful picture of a body of believers established and anchored in their faith in Christ. In fact, as we went through the whole letter to the Ephesians, we received encouragement that we have been joined together for the purpose of growing into a holy temple in the Lord (Eph 2:21). And we also wanted to grow in our identity as Anglican worshippers. For many at St Hilda's this is who we are because we have grown up in the Anglican Church. But many have joined over the years who come from different denominations or are new to the Christian faith. We all enjoyed the special sermon series through the Anglican liturgy and have found more meaning in those words that we sometimes recite in 'auto-mode'.



In August, we invited Ps Benny Ho to be the speaker for an in-house conference under the theme 'Let's Get Going!' Ps Benny shared from the Book of Haggai where God challenges his people through the words of this 'minor' prophet to review their priorities in life and give first attention to the building of His house. The people who had often dismissed the words of the major prophets, humbled themselves and got going together, young and old, in an amazing, collaborative effort that would create a temple that served for worship for almost 600 years. Ps Benny helped us to look beyond our differences in age and worship style and focus on what is essential: To Worship God in Spirit and in Truth (John 4:24).

The purpose of placing an emphasis on unity and identity was to prepare our parish for two significant changes in 2025. The joining in worship of our E2 and E3 community in August and the discontinuation of our Saturday Evening Service (SES) and the start of a Mid-Week Holy Communion Service (MWS) in December. The joining of E2 + E3 to our new 10.15 Service had been prepared for almost 2 years. There was great joy when we started on 17th August. We have since been blessed with our younger generation serving in many ways and expressing themselves in vibrant worship. All glory to God!



The discontinuation of SES was prayerfully considered, planned and communicated throughout 2025. It was a difficult decision as worshippers had adjusted their weekly rhythm since the service began in 2020. We were aware that not all worshippers would be able to attend the MWS, and some would find it difficult to change back to Sunday. We give thanks to the Lord that almost all made an effort and remained in the church that they so love.

Such changes can only be attempted with care and because our members have a sense of belonging to St Hilda's Church for which we give thanks to the Lord!

There were many moments of joy in 2025. You find them in the carefully drafted ministry reports. A big thanks to all ministry leaders and coordinators who have put so much effort in preparing the reports and even more in faithfully leading our ministries every year.



There is one initiative this year that stood out. When Revd David Lee presented the work of the school chaplains in September 2024, the Lord planted an idea in the hearts of our Arise & Shine 8AM Children's Ministry. In the course of 2025, the children and teachers diligently prepared handmade crafts for the Christmas season, pouring much time, effort, and love into each item. These were sold to our members over two Sundays in October. By God's grace, we managed to raise \$2,810, exceeding our original target of \$2,000.

2026

The year has started very well. We changed our theme to *'The Fear of the Lord is the Beginning of ...'* with the verse from John 10:10b *'I came that they may have life and have it abundantly.'* When the leaders came together in January, we could see the fruits of unity and renewed vigour.

On 11th January, Archbishop Titus came to confirm 20 candidates, a day of great rejoicing!

From there, we embarked on a sermon series through the Book of Proverbs, a much-treasured book which is rarely preached on. The Bible is truly a wonderful provision of the Lord to his Church.

Our fellowship in the Manna House on Sundays and Thursdays is growing. It is very encouraging to see our members enjoying food and company in Christ. Joyce Siew, who coordinates the Manna House refreshments ministry, had the idea of placing our monthly memory verse on each table. This helps us to remember that the Manna House is not just a place of physical refreshment but one where we encourage each other in our faith.



As agreed at the leaders' meeting in January, we will put a stronger emphasis on Cell Ministry this year. The month of May will be set aside to preach a short sermon series on cell ministry and to encourage our members to join / rejoin cells. Please pray that this initiative will bear fruit.

We are also looking forward to our annual Church Camp in June where the Archdeacon of our Diocese, Ven Daniel Wee will be sharing God's Word with us.

I would like to conclude this short report by thanking our Lord for watching over St Hilda's Church and all our members. He is worthy of all blessing and honour, glory and power for ever and ever. Amen!

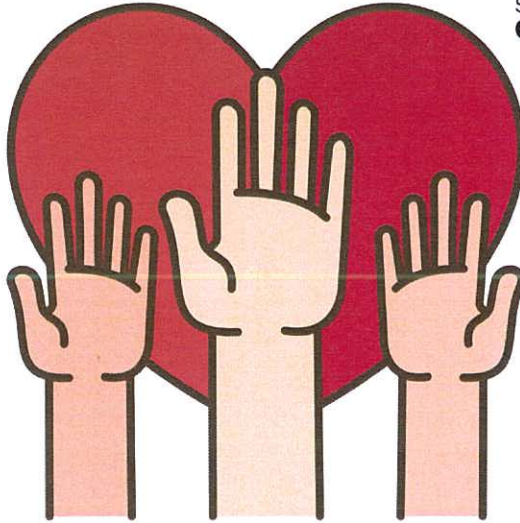

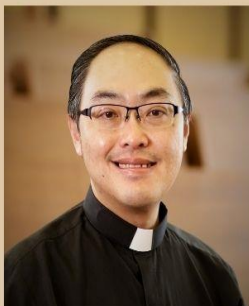
