在基督里亲爱的弟兄姐妹们，

当我们踏入这个后疫情时代的新年时，约沙法王的祷告似乎非常适合我们这个时刻（历代志下20:12）：“...我们无力抵挡这来攻击我们的大军，我们也不知道怎样行，我们的眼目单仰望你。”确实，我们面临着许多挑战，尤其是社会的迅速变化和人口老龄化。在面对广泛而频繁的变革时，很容易感到绝望或无助。这篇祷告提醒我们不要将目光专注于“这地的巨人”，而是应该注视那场属于主的争战上。上帝的子民必须始终依靠上帝的手来取得胜利。

因此，我们心里怀着信心，我们必须紧握福音在逆境中为我们呈现的巨大机遇 - 在本笃会的箴言“*ora et labora*”中找到平衡：祷告和工作。让我们的重担驱使我们屈服于祷告中，寻求上帝的旨意和力量。当我们这样做时，我们就是在充分利用我们最伟大的资源。我们的教会需要祷告，祈求力量和勇气，以在逆流面前持守信仰。我们需要祈祷，寻求更坚定的决心，专注于造就门徒和建立忠实的社群，为周围世界的黑暗投下一道光明。我们需要为内外的转变祷告，并呼吁上帝兴起坚强而复兴的教会。

与此同时，我们有实质性的工作要去完成。那就是关爱教友并照顾有需要的人，展示上帝国度的好处，以及忠实传扬上帝的话语和国度的好消息。这是保罗对提摩太的劝勉，要在苦难面前完成他的事工并尽职尽责（提摩太后书4:1-5，并为福音的真实和能力作见证。

因此，我在基督里的弟兄姐妹们，我要劝勉你们继续遵守新的诫命并履行大使命，这是我们主耶稣基督的双重教导，但不要依赖我们自己的力量，而要将目光仰望那位为我们信心创始成终的主（希伯来书12:2）。
