Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ at St Hilda's Church,

Grace and peace be with you from our Lord who promises to be with us always.

I know that as a Church you are going through an intense time of bereavement. Six beloved members have passed on in a short span of only 13 days. Indeed we grieve together as a family in Christ at their departure. Many of you would have vivid memories of times spent together with our late brothers and sisters in Christ, especially of those precious times serving the Lord together. Let us continue to uphold their family members and friends in prayer - May our good Lord continue to comfort them and give them strength.

We were all very saddened by the passing of Ps Allison and her mother, who passed within only 14 hours from each other. I give thanks to the Lord for Ps Allison's faithful service over three decades, particularly her ministry among the seniors. Her joy in the Lord and ever-ready care for all in need was well appreciated within the Diocese. She will be dearly missed. I would like to express my condolences to her family as they lost both mother and sister at the same time.

I am reminded that St Hilda's Church is turning 90 this year. I would like to look at this with gratitude unto the Lord for he has kept you faithful. Each one of the six who have passed on in faith have received the crown of righteousness. This is a testimony of God's mercy and of the strong discipleship at St Hilda's over the decades. In the midst of our grieve, I hope you will not forget to also seek the Lord to strengthen you, that you may remain faithful in Him who has redeemed you.

It is my prayer that you may be able to say together with St Paul in 2 Corinthians 4:8-10: 'We are afflicted in every way, but not crushed; perplexed, but not driven to despair; ... always carrying in the body the death of Jesus, so that the life of Jesus may also be manifested in our bodies.'
