Dear St Hilda’s Family,

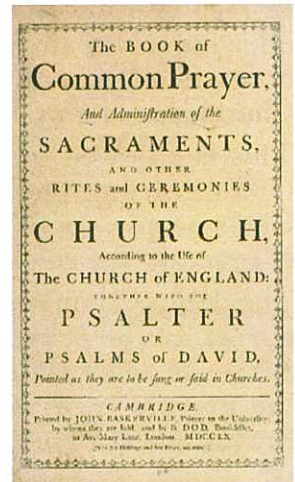
Blessings to you and your loved ones as we have entered 2025 and a new lunar year. We already have lots to thank the Lord for in the past few weeks.

Our theme in 2025 is *‘Being ONE in Christ’* and the anchor verse comes from Ephesians 4:4-6 *‘There is one body and one Spirit ... one Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all.’* We went through John 17 and realized how precious the unity among his disciples (past and present) is for our Lord Jesus.

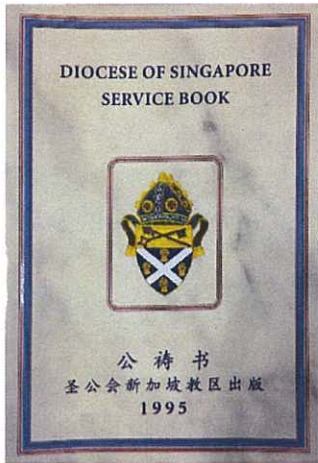
One important aspect of unity is our common identity. We are (1) Christian, (2) Anglican, and (3) members of St Hilda’s Church. Over the next ~3 months, we will take a closer look at what it means to be Anglican.

Anglicans do not have a lexicon where we can check Anglican theology, unlike e.g. the Presbyterian Church that relies on Calvin’s *‘Institutes of the Christian Religion’*. As Anglicans, “we pray what we believe, and we believe what we pray.” This explains the centrality of the liturgy in our worship. Our liturgies can be found in the Book of Common Prayer which – contrary to general perception – is not a book of old-fashioned prayers that the church should follow. Instead, it was Thomas Cranmer’s attempt to bring the Church back to God’s Word. Almost every sentence of our service prayers is deeply rooted in Scripture.

The aim of our sermon series is to bring out the biblical foundations of our liturgy.



As we embark on this series, allow me to draft the flow of our Holy Communion Service. For some of you, this might be very familiar, for others, this brief explanation might help you to better appreciate our liturgy.



We begin with a Call to Worship. This is the ringing of the bell to call the people nearby to walk over in time for the service to begin 😊. We call upon the Lord's presence in our gathering as we sing the processional hymn and greet one another with "The Lord is here".

We prepare our hearts with the Collect of Purity, committing ourselves to keeping God's Commandments and realizing that we cannot keep them except for his mercy. We therefore confess our sins and receive restoring forgiveness.

As forgiven people, we worship the Lord with the Gloria in Excelsis which we usually replace with songs of praise and adoration.

After concluding this section with the Collect, we expose ourselves to the reading and proclamation of God's Word, the sermon.

In response to God's Word, we confess our faith with the Creed and offer ourselves afresh to the Lord in the offertory (though our actual order is slightly different). In between, we lift up the needs of the Church and the world to the Lord in intercession.

This is followed by a key moment in our gathering, the receiving of God's Peace through the pastor and the exchange of the same among God's people. As forgiven and reconciled people, we come to the table of grace, in the celebration of Holy Communion.

The Holy Communion prayers are a wonderful presentation of the gospel. In the prayer of consecration, the bread and wine on the table are set aside for the celebration of Holy Communion. The remainder of the prayers express our dependency on our Lord, even the Lord's Prayer and the Humble Access.

We receive and consume the elements in an act of intimacy with the Lord and of 'holy communion' as the body of Christ, his Church.

Post communion, we give thanks to the Lord for feeding us spiritually and receive his blessing.

The service 'ends' with the dismissal 'Go in Peace to Love and Serve the Lord'. This is usually followed by a song or recessional hymn. As we adjourn to the Manna House, it is important to realize that the post-service fellowship is still a part of the gathering of God's people. 😊

In short, our service has four movements: Gathering / Word / Sacrament / Dismissal. Anglican services centre around the Word and the Sacrament of Holy Communion.



The above summary and explanations are not perfect. It is our prayer that our sermon series will provide a deeper understanding.

As a child and teenager, I grew up in a liturgical church (Lutheran). I found the words of the liturgy difficult to understand and the repetitiveness boring. After I gave my life to Christ, the Holy Spirit helped me to grasp the richness of the liturgy in worship. It is my sincere hope that we will be able to make our liturgy accessible to our next generations and form within them an Anglican identity.
